INVITATION FOR BIDS

Issuance Date: 03 March 2021

Deadline for Submission of Bids: 22 April 2021, 10:00 am (local time)

1. The Kingdom of Cambodia has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of Second Urban Environmental Management in the Tonle Sap Basin Project. A portion of this financing will be applied for eligible payments under the contract named above. The bidding is open to bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB. The eligibility rules and procedures of ADB will govern the bidding process.
2. The Ministry of Public Works and Transport (MPWT) (“the Employer”) hereby invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction and completion of the following contract package.

3. The Works include:
 - Upgrading of 2,150 meters of access road to the landfill site to be above flood levels.
 - Construction of one controlled landfill cells out of a total of four cells.
 - Construction of one hazardous waste landfill cell.
 - Construction of a non-mechanical type material recovery facility (MRF).
 - Construction of drainage, leachate collection, treatment, and recirculation system.
 - Construction of weighbridge and office building; staff dining and rest room; workshop, electrical and mechanical room, and supply building.
 - Construction of 1,403 meters of concrete internal roads, bunds, and drainage system.
 - Construction of wire mesh fencing, and entrance wall, gate and security guardhouse.
 - Construction of car/ vehicle washing facility.
 - Construction of hazardous waste storage.
 - Provision of operations & maintenance (O&M) equipment
4. The International Competitive Bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s Single Stage One-Envelope Bidding Procedure with post Qualifications and is open to all bidders from eligible countries
5. Eligible bidders must meet the qualification criteria in the bidding documents, including but not limited to:
 - (i) The bidders’ net worth within last year shall be positive.
 - (ii) Minimum average annual construction turnover of **US\$8.71 million** calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years.
 - (iii) The bidder must demonstrate that its financial resources defined in FIN - 3, less its financial obligations for its current contract commitments defined in FIN - 4, meet or exceed the total requirement for the Subject Contract of **US\$1.09 million**.

(iv) Participation in at least one contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last five (5) years and that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds **US\$4.36 million**. The similarity of the Bidder's participation shall be based on the physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods, technology or other characteristics as described in Section 6 (Employer's Requirements).

7. To purchase the bidding documents in English eligible bidders should submit a written application to H.E. Vong Pisith, Project Director at the address under para. 6 above requesting for the bidding documents for Contract Package No. PMU/MPWT/TS-2/ICB/CW03b and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of US\$250 or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel being 1,000,000.00 Riel. The method of payment will be in cash or deposit to Bank account No.000000001333 of National Bank of Cambodia. The Bidding Documents may be collected in person, or may be sent by email or courier, at the discretion of the bidder, but the bidder has to deposit the fee at the above bank account and to pay for courier charge by his/her arrangement as appropriate. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for the purchase of the bidding documents.

The bidding documents can be purchased during normal working days from between 8:00 am – 11:30 am and 2:30 pm – 5:00 pm at the address under 6 above, from 03 March 2021.

8. Bidders should deliver their bids:

(i) To the address given under item 6 above **on or before the deadline: 10:00 am (local time) on 22 April 2021.**

(ii) Together with a Bid Security in the amount as specified in the Bidding Documents. For the purpose of determining the equivalent amount of the required Bid Security in a freely convertible currency, the selling exchange rate published by the National Bank of Cambodia on the date 28 days prior to the deadline for Bid submission shall be applied.

Bids will be opened immediately after the deadline, in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend.

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bids and the Employer shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
