1. The Kingdom of Cambodia has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of **Fourth Greater Mekong Subregion Corridor Towns Development Project**. A portion of this financing will be applied for eligible payments under the contract named above. The bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB.
2. The **Ministry of Public Works and Transport (MPWT)** (“the Employer”) hereby invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the construction and completion of the following contract package (“the Works”):

The Works include:

- Construction of a primary, secondary and tertiary sewage collection network,
- Construction of service connections for 2,351 households, commercial and institutional buildings including onsite plumbing,
- Construction of three (3) sewage pumping stations and associated pumping mains,
- Upgrading of existing one (1) storm drainage pump station with additional one pump in existing pump station building, associated pumping main, other additional allied unit and structures,
- Land Development for wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) area,
- Land development for pumping stations,
- Construction of a 2,900 m³/day WWTP above flood levels,
- Construction of administration, workshop, electrical and guard buildings at WWTP,
- Construction of 1800 meters storm drainage diversion (φ800–φ1000) for storm water management including outlet structure,
- Provision of Operations & Maintenance Equipment.

3. **International Competitive Bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualification should participate in this Bidding:
- (i) The bidders' net worth within last year shall be positive.
 - (ii) Minimum average annual construction turnover of **US\$14.60 million** calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years (2018-2019 & 2020).
 - (iii) The bidder must demonstrate that its financial resources defined in FIN - 3, less its financial obligations for its current contract commitments defined in FIN - 4, meet or exceed the total requirement for the Subject Contract of **US\$1.83 million**
 - (iv) Participation in at least one (1) contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last eight (8) years and that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds **US\$17.50 million**. Contract of similar nature involving construction of wastewater treatment plant, and Sewers/Sewerages and drainage system.

The Contractor can meet each of the experience requirements stated above ("wastewater treatment plant", "sewer", "drainage") under separate reference contracts. Also, a reference contract may be used to demonstrate one or more of the experience requirements stated. At least one reference contract should exceed the stated value threshold
 - (v) For the above or other contracts executed during the period stipulated in (iv) above, a minimum construction experience in the following key activities: (a) Wastewater treatment plant, capacity at least 2,000 cu.m per day; (b) HDPE (or equivalent material) sewers (200 mm diameter or larger) at least 5.0km in length; (c) Storm Drainage, any material, (at least 1.0 m diameter or a cross-section of 0.785 m² for other shape), at least 500m in length.

The qualification criteria are more completely described in the Bidding Document.

6. To purchase the Bidding Documents in English, eligible Bidders should:

- (i) Write to address above requesting for the Bidding Documents for the Contract Package No. PMU/MPWT/CTDP4/ICB/CW08
- (ii) Pay a non-refundable fee of US\$250 or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel being 1,000,000.00 Riel. The method of payment will be in cash or deposit to Bank account No.000000001333 of National Bank of Cambodia. The Bidding Documents may be collected in person, or may be sent by email or courier, at the discretion of the bidder, but the bidder has to deposit the fee at the above bank account and to pay for courier charge by his/her arrangement as appropriate. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for the purchase of the bidding documents.

The Bidding Documents may be collected in person, or may be sent by email or courier, at the discretion of the bidder, but the bidder has to deposit the fee at the above bank account and to pay for courier charge by his/her arrangement as appropriate. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for the purchase of the Bidding Documents.

The Bidding Documents can be purchased during normal working days from between 8:00 am – 11:30 am and 2:30 pm – 5:00 pm at the address indicated in para. 6 above, from 13 December 2021.

7. Deliver bids:

- (i) To the address given under item 6 above **on or before the deadline: 10:00 a.m. (local time) on 27 January 2022.**
- (ii) Together with a Bid Security as specified in the Bidding Documents. For the purpose of determining the equivalent amount of the required Bid Security in a freely convertible currency, the selling exchange rate published by the National Bank of Cambodia on the date 28 days prior to the deadline for Bid submission shall be applied.

Bids will be opened immediately after the deadline, in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend.

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bids and the Employer shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process
