Construction of Battambang Night Market

1. The Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) represented by the Ministry of Economy and Finance has received a Grant from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) to provide assistance on the grant basis from JFPR (the JFPR Assistance) for the Greater Mekong Subregion (GMS) Livelihood Support for Corridor Towns Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds of the Grant to payments under Contract Ref. No.: PMU/MPWT/GMSLSCTP/NCB/CW01 for the **Construction of Battambang Night Market**
2. The Project Management Unit of MPWT now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the **Construction of Battambang Night Market**. The construction period is 180 days from date of notification to commence.
3. Procurement will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding Procedures outlined in the Procurement Manual for Externally Financed Projects/Programs, and under the laws and regulations governing public procurement within the Kingdom of Cambodia,
4. This invitation is open to all eligible bidders from eligible source countries as described in the Bidding Document.
5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below between 8:00 am – 11:30 am and 2:30 pm – 5:00 pm on all working days from **03 April to 3 May 2017**.
6. Interested bidders' attention is drawn to Sub Clause 6.3 and 6.1(g) of the Instructions to Bidders in the Bidding Documents including: average annual volume of construction work; construction experience of a nature and complexity equivalent to the works; the liquid assets and/or credit facilities; essential equipment and key personnel.
7. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on submission of a written application to **Mr. Pou Manith**, Procurement Officer, at PMU-Office Third Floor, Western Building, CNR Norodom Blvd, & St #106, Phnom Penh, Cambodia and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of USD 150 or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel being **600,000 Riel**. The method of payment will be in cash or deposit to Bank account No. 000000001333 of National Bank of Cambodia. The Bidding Documents may be collected in person or may be sent by email or courier, but the bidder has to deposit the fee at the above bank account and to pay for courier charge by his/her arrangement as appropriate at the discretion of bidder. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for the purchase of the bidding documents.

Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives and other interested person who choose to attend in person at the address below at **10:00 a.m. (local time) on 3 May 2017**
10. The bid shall be accompanied by a **Bid Securing Declaration** as described in the Instruction to Bidders.
11. The Government of Cambodia and Asian Development Bank will respectively declare a firm ineligible either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract funded by the Government of Cambodia and/or Asian Development Bank, if it at any time it determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent, coercive or collusive practices in competing for or in executing a contract.
