Wishes to Purchase: 3 Units of 4WD Double Cabin Pick-up Trucks and 2 Units of Station Wagon

1. The Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Fourth Greater Mekong Sub-region Corridor Towns Development Project and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this ADB Loan/Grant No. 3686/0592/0593 CAM to payments under the Contract No.: PMU/MPWT/CT-4/NCB/G01 for the Supply and Delivery of 3 Units of 4WD Double Cabin Pick-up Trucks and 2 Units of Station Wagon.
2. The Ministry of Public Works and Transport as Executing Agency (EA) now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the for the Supply and Delivery of 3 Units of 4WD Double Cabin Pick-up Trucks and 2 Units of Station Wagon.
3. Procurement will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding Procedures and under the laws and regulations governing public procurement within the Kingdom of Cambodia.
4. This invitation is open to all eligible bidders from eligible source countries as described in Clause 6.1 under Special Condition of Contract (SCC) in the Bidding Document.
5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from **Mr. Pou Manith**, Project Manager Officer, e-mail: poumanith@yahoo.com and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00 to 11:00 and 14:00 to 17:00 on working days.
6. Qualification requirements include:
  - (a) Copies of original documents defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration, and principal place of business evidencing legal status in an eligible source country as defined in GCC Sub-Clause 6.1.
  - (b) In the case of a bidder offering to supply goods under the contract which the bidder does not manufacture or otherwise produce, the bidder has been duly authorized by the goods' manufacturer or producer to supply the goods in Cambodia;
  - (c) The bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following experience and financial requirements:
    - i. that the bidder has satisfactorily completed at least two contracts for supply of similar goods in the preceding three years of not less than 50% of the bid price in each contract.
    - ii. that the bidder has completed contracts in the total accumulative amount equal to at least two times the value of bid price in the preceding two years.
    - iii. that the bidder has availability of liquid assets through either:
      - Access to a line of credit or cash in a bank account of an amount at least 50% of the bid price, net of other contractual commitments;

OR

- Credit terms with vendors specifically for the goods to be supplied under the contract, and valid for at least 6 months after the deadline for submission of bids specified in ITB Clause 21.

Sub-contractors' qualifications shall not be taken into account in establishing the Bidder's qualifications to perform the contract.

- (d) that, in the case of a Bidder not doing business within Cambodia, the Bidder is or will be (if awarded the contract) represented by an agent in Cambodia equipped and able to carry out the Supplier's maintenance, repair, and spare parts stocking obligations described in the Conditions of Contract and/or Technical Specifications and
  - (e) that the Bidder gives to the Purchaser the authority to seek references from the bidder's bankers
7. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address given below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **50.00 US Dollars** or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel being **200,000.00 Riels**. The method of payment will be in cash or deposit to Bank account No.000000001333 of National Bank of Cambodia. The Bidding Documents may be collected in person or may be sent by email or courier, but the bidder has to deposit the fee at the above bank account and to pay for courier charge by his/her arrangement as appropriate at the discretion of the bidder. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for purchase of the bidding documents.

Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives and the project's beneficiaries from the concerned local community who choose to attend shall be allowed to be present in person at the address given below at **10:00 am on 23 April 2020**.
10. All bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Securing Declaration as described in the Instructions to Bidders.
11. The Royal Government of Cambodia and/or the Asian Development Bank will respectively declare a bidder ineligible either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract financed by the Royal Government of Cambodia and/or Asian Development Bank respectively, if at any time determines that the bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent, coercive, collusive or obstructive practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
