Wishes to Purchase: 3 units of 4WD Double Cabin Pick-up Truck

1. The Royal Government of Cambodia has received a Loan from the Asian Development Bank towards the cost of the Second Greater Mekong Sub-region (GMS) Corridor Towns Development Project. The Ministry of Public Works and Transport (MPWT), as the Executing Agency (EA), intends to apply part of this Loan to eligible payments under the Contracts No. PMU/MPWT/CTDP-2/G02 for the Supply and Delivery of 3 units of 4WD Double Cabin Pick-up Truck. The eligibility of bidders and of goods and services offered are subject to the applicable rules of the Asian Development Bank.
2. The goods are required to be supplied and delivered within 4 weeks from the date of contract signing.
3. Interested qualified eligible suppliers are invited to obtain a copy of the bidding documents free-of-charge from the address given below by submitting a written application. Except for the submission of a written application, there shall be no other conditions for obtaining the bidding documents.
4. To be considered eligible and qualified a bidder must
 - i) Be from an ADB member country.
 - ii) Have completed within the last 3 years at least one contract of a similar nature of at least 50% of the value of the bid.
 - iii) Have completed in the last 2 years, contracts with a total cumulative value of three times that bid.
 - iv) Not be under any notice of disbarment issued by the Royal Government of Cambodia or the Asian Development Bank.
5. Bids must be delivered to the address given below at or before 10.00 (local time) on 08 June 2017. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in public immediately thereafter at the address given below in the presence of the Bidders' representatives and the project's beneficiaries from the concerned local community who choose to attend shall be allowed to be present in person.
6. The Purchaser shall award the Contract to the Bidder whose offer has been determined to be the lowest evaluated bid and is substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents, provided further that the Bidder is determined to be qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily.
7. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid and Performance Securing Declaration as described in the bidding documents. Any bid not accompanied by one will be rejected as non-compliant
