

## Invitation for Bids

- The Royal Government of Cambodia has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Second Urban Environmental Management in the Tonle Sap Basin Project**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the Contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
- The **Ministry of Public Works and Transport** (“the Employer”) invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified Bidders for the construction and completion of the following works contract package:

The Works include:

- Upgrading of 1,350 metres of the external access road to the landfill site to be above flood levels.
- Construction of two controlled landfill cells.
- Construction of one hazardous waste landfill cell.
- Construction of a non-mechanical type material recovery facility (MRF).
- Construction of drainage, leachate collection, treatment, and recirculation system.
- Construction of weighbridge.
- Construction of office, staff dining and restroom (combined building).
- Construction of workshop, electrical and mechanical room.
- Construction of hazardous waste storage building.
- Construction of a supply building.
- Construction of 278 metres of concrete internal roads, with associated bunds and drainage.
- Construction of wire mesh fencing, brick entrance wall, gate and security guardhouse.
- Construction of vehicle washing facility.
- Provision of utilities.
- Provision of operations & maintenance (O&M) equipment (separate from the landfill project).

3. **International Competitive Bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in the bidding:
  - The Bidders' net worth within last year shall be positive.
  - Minimum average annual construction turnover of US\$7.66 million calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years.
  - The Bidder must demonstrate that its financial resources defined in FIN - 3, less its financial obligations for its current contract commitments defined in FIN - 4, meet or exceed the total requirement for the Subject Contract of US\$1.28 million.
  - Participation in at least one (1) contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last five (5) years and that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds US\$5.79 million. The requirement of working experience is detailed in Section 3: Evaluation and Qualification Criteria, Paragraph 2.4 Construction Experience of the Bidding Document.

6. To purchase a complete set of Bidding Documents in English, eligible Bidders should submit a written application to H.E. Vong Pisith, Project Director at the address above requesting for the Bidding Documents and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of US\$250 or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel being 1,000,000.00 Riel.

The method of payment will be in cash or deposit to Bank account No.000000001333 of National Bank of Cambodia. The Bidding Documents may be collected in person, or may be sent by email or courier, at the discretion of the Bidder, but the Bidder has to deposit the fee at the above bank account and to pay for courier charge by his/her arrangement as appropriate. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee, there shall be no other conditions for the purchase of the bidding documents.

The Bidding Documents can be purchased during normal working days from between 8:00 – 11:30 hours in the morning and 14:30 – 17:00 hours at the address above.

7. Bids must be delivered to the address above **on or before 21 July 2023 10:00 hours (local time)** together with a Bid Security in the amount as specified in the Bidding Documents. For the purpose of determining the equivalent amount of the required Bid Security in a freely convertible currency, the selling exchange rate published by the National Bank of Cambodia on the date 28 days prior to the deadline for bid submission shall be applied.

Bids will be opened immediately after the deadline, in the presence of Bidders'

representatives who choose to attend.

The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bids and the Employer shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
