### INVITATION FOR BIDS

#### **Construction of Landfill in Kampot**

1. The Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) represented by the Ministry of Economy and Finance has received a Loan and Grant from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) for Second Greater Mekong Subregion (GMS) Corridor Town Development Project and intends to apply part of the Loan/Grant proceed to payments under Contract Ref. No.: PMU/MPWT/CTDP-2/NCB/CW02 for the works, Construction of Landfill in Kampot.
2. The Ministry of Public Works and Transport now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the Contract No. **PMU/MPWT/CTDP-2/NCB/CW02**. The construction period is twelve (12) months from date of notification to commence.
3. Procurement will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding Procedures outlined in the Procurement Manual for Externally Financed Projects/Programs, and under the laws and regulations governing public procurement within the Kingdom of Cambodia,
4. This invitation is open to all eligible bidders from eligible source countries as described in the Bidding Document.
5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below between 8:00 am – 11:30 am and 2:30 pm – 5:00 pm on all working days from **18 February 2021**.
6. The qualifications requirements include: The bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following experience and financial requirements:
  - The average annual volume of construction work of the successful bidder over the last three years (2017-2018 & 2019) shall be US\$5.81 million.
  - The bidder has substantially or successfully completed at least one similar contract as a prime contractor in the last five (5) years prior to the bid submission date where the value of the bidder's participation exceeds US\$2.33 million.
  - The bidder has substantially or successfully completed at least one contract as prime contractor in the last five (5) years prior to the bid submission date where the scope of works under the contract included the completion of earthworks activities with a minimum volume of 60,000 cu.m.
  - The bidder has substantially or successfully completed at least one contract as prime contractor in the last five (5) years prior to the bid submission date where the scope of works under the contract included the completion of asphalt activities with a minimum area of 20,000 sq.m.
  - The minimum amount of liquid assets and/or credit facilities net of other contractual commitments of the successful Bidder shall be US\$0.73 million.
  - More details of the requirements are provided in the Bidding Documents.

7. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on submission of a written application to **Mr. Pou Manith**, Procurement Officer, at PMU-Office, First Floor, Road 598 SK Sangkat Chraing Chamres II, Khan Russey Keo, Phnom Penh, Cambodia and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of USD 150 or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel being 600,000 Riel. The method of payment will be in cash or deposit to Bank account No.000000001333 (Bank Account Name: General Department of National Treasury) of National Bank of Cambodia. The Bidding Documents may be collected in person or may be sent by email or courier, but the bidder has to deposit the fee at the above bank account and to pay for courier charge by his/her arrangement as appropriate at the discretion of bidder. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for the purchase of the bidding documents.
8. In case of any difficulty in purchase of the bidding documents, interested parties may contact in writing to **H.E. 9. Bids must be delivered to the address given below (para.13) on or before **10:00 a.m. (local time) on 19 March 2021**. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives and other interested person who choose to attend in person at the address below at **10:00 a.m. (local time) on 19 March 2021**.
10. The bid shall be accompanied by a **Bid Securing Declaration** as described in the Instruction to Bidders.
11. The Government of Cambodia and Asian Development Bank will respectively declare a firm ineligible either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract funded by the Government of Cambodia and/or Asian Development Bank, if it at any time it determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent, coercive or collusive practices in competing for or in executing a contract.
